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Why use apprenticeships?

Apprenticeships can be used to:

- Offer development to existing employees (helping them to potentially advance in the CCG or elsewhere in the NHS)
- Expand a team with an apprentice that wasn't originally in the team structure (subject to the usual CCG approvals process PLUS the apprenticeship levy fund only covers the training costs not the salary costs)
- Turn an existing post into an apprenticeship and offer a development opportunity (to note, applicants won't all necessarily be younger persons whilst apprenticeships can be offered at all levels)
- Help people to train for and fill those 'hard to fill' vacancies
- Succession plan

General Apprenticeship Information

- Covers a wide range of professions, subjects and specialist areas at different levels
- Level 2/GCSE to Level 7/Masters are available
- Takes 12 months or even up to 4 years to complete (the time limit to complete depends on the apprenticeship)
- Funding is available via the CCG, other NHS
 organisations or even a private sector business (a
 levy transfer is used if the CCG runs out of funds)

Leadership & Management Courses/Apprenticeships on Offer

- Level 2 Qualification The Principles of Team Leading can be completed by anyone and is free (6-8 weeks course)
 [Vocationally related qualification or VRQ] see slide 26 for more information
- <u>Level 3</u> Apprenticeship **Team Leader & Supervisor** (12 months) [ILM or CMI qualification & standards]
- <u>Level 5</u> Apprenticeship <u>Operations & Departmental</u>
 <u>Manager</u> (30 months) [ILM or CMI qualification & standards]
- <u>Level 7</u> Apprenticeship **Senior Leader** (24 months)
 [No qualification, standards only]

The 4 hurdles (maybe a 5th) to undertaking an apprenticeship

- 1. Must be contracted for **30 hours** as a minimum if an **entry level apprentice** but not if already employed by the CCG (the provider must still be able to accommodate a part-time apprentice)
- 2. Funding (but not really as things stand)
- 3. Experiences are needed to meet the standards and complete the apprenticeship (these are absolutely critical)
- 4. 20% of contracted time is needed to undertake the apprenticeship (but this commitment isn't quite what it seems). To note, this links to the End Point Assessment (EPA) so must be evidenced
- 5. Too many employees, all at the same time, from one team may not be able to logically undertake an apprenticeship (links to No.3 above)

Government Incentive Payments for taking on Entry Level Apprentices

£2,000 for **under** 25 year olds £1,500 for **over** 25 year olds (until the 31st January 2021)

£1,000 extra for 16 to 18 year olds

Free VRQs @ Level 2

Flexible/On-line Vocationally Related Qualification (or VRQs)

The following are just some of the topics that are **free to study** (over a 6 week period) and can lead to a VRQ Certificate at Level 2 (the same level of study as a GCSE):

- The Principles of Team Leading
- Lean Organisational Management Techniques
- Business Improvement Techniques
- Principles of Business Admin
- Customer Service
- Information, Advice or Guidance
- Understanding Data Protection and Data Security
- Digital Skills
- Understanding Safeguarding & Prevent
- Equality & Diversity
- LGBT Inclusion in the Workplace
- Understanding Climate Change and Environmental Awareness

To note, you should only undertake these during your contracted hours if the study relates to your role or even a future NHS role and that the study time has been agreed with your Line Manager. You are of course welcome to study for any of the VRQs in your own time

Improving Functional skills with BKSB

Would you like to improve your **English and/or Mathematics** ability (up to level 2)? This could be for work purposes, in readiness for or whilst completing further study/an apprenticeship

BKSB are offering CCG employees the opportunity to access, completely **free of charge**, an **on-line learning tool until April 2021** (this end date might be extended)

This tool will provide you with **self-directed study** which you will be able to access via a laptop, desktop computer or even a smart phone

To explain, there are **5 stages** to using the on-line learning tool

- 1. **Initial Assessment** (this takes a snapshot of where you are on your learning journey)
- 2. Diagnostic Assessment (this breaks down your skills and explains where you need to practice)
- 3. Access to Learning Resources (this is tailored to you and helps you build your skills)
- 4. **Progress Check** (this checks how you are doing)
- 5. **Exam Practice** (here you can if you want/need to work through mock papers although to note there is no actual exam included as part of this offer)
