- The number of individuals living <u>outside</u> of Nottinghamshire County Council area care homes split by age 0-18yrs, 18yrs-65yrs, 65yrs+ in Residential Care (Learning Disabilities) at the end of March 2021 funded by CCG and the Average Weekly Fees per person.
- The number of individuals living <u>outside</u> of Nottinghamshire County Council area care homes split by age 0-18yrs, 18yrs-65yrs, 65yrs+ in Nursing Care (Learning Disabilities) at the end of March 2021 funded by the CCG and the Average Weekly Fees per person.
- 5. The number of individuals living in Supported Living Accommodation at the end of 2020/21 funded by the CCG and the Average Weekly Fees.
- The number of individuals living <u>outside</u> of Nottinghamshire County Council area but funded by the CCG in Supported Living Accommodation (Learning Disabilities) at the end of March 2021 and the Average Weekly Fees per person. Please breakdown in to care costs and housing costs.

Please can you also provide me with the following information for 2018/19, 2019/20 and 2020/21:

- 7. The number of new placements in to Adult Learning Disability residential services funded by the CCG and the weekly fee paid for each of these new placements. Please specify whether the placement was nursing or residential.
- 8. The number of new placements in to Adult Learning Disability supported living funded by the CCG and the weekly fee paid for each of these new placements. Please breakdown in to care costs and housing costs.

Please see attached Excel document in response to the above request.

Where ≤5 has been used the information cannot be disclosed as it could potentially identify the individuals involved, especially if combined with other data, and this would constitute a breach of the Data Protection Act 2018. Therefore, this information is exempt from disclosure under section 40(2) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 on the grounds that it is personal information.

If you are unhappy with the way in which your request has been handled, NHS Nottingham and Nottinghamshire Clinical Commissioning Group have an internal review procedure through which you can raise any concerns you might have.
