Bereavement Service Directory

There are many organisations available to offer support when a family experiences a baby loss during or soon after pregnancy. However, it is difficult to know what is on offer or how to find the most suitable support. It is hoped that this directory can help navigating all the options available.

The directory is split into two sections for local support and national support. The organisations in each section are then listed in alphabetical order, with contact details and a brief overview provided.

To help find the most suitable support, a coloured key to indicate the age of child when they died is included.

Ticks for each listing help to identify the kind of support offered and how to refer into the organisation to request help.
