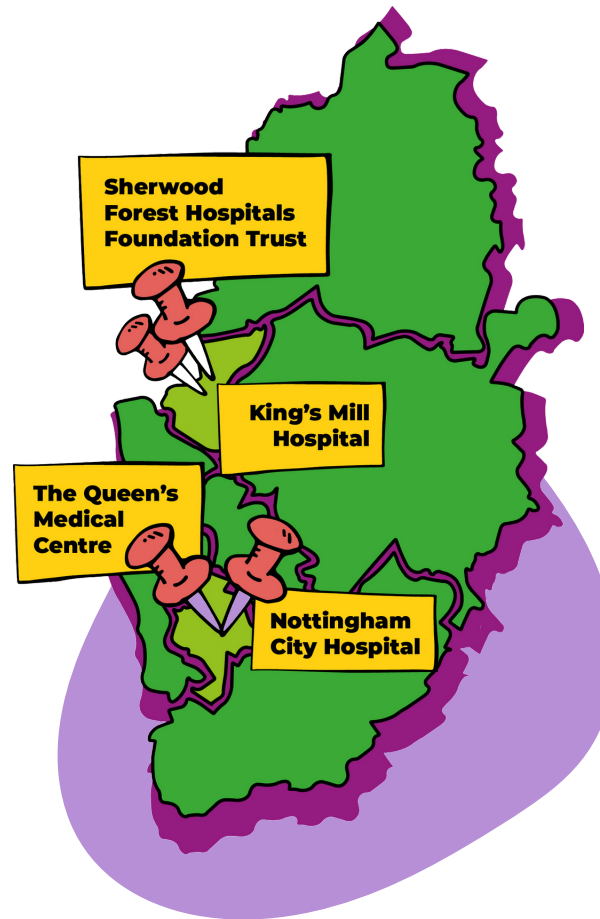


WHAT IS A MATERNITY VOICES PARTNERSHIP?

A Maternity Voices Partnership (MVP) is an independent team made up of birthing people and their families; commissioners (who plan, buy and monitor services); providers (who deliver services such as midwives and doctors); the Integrated Care System (ICS); who commission health services, and the Local Authority (LA), who commission public health and social care and support services.
