**Dear Patient** 

As a patient of Skegby Family Medical Centre or Brierley Park Medical Centre, we are writing to let you know about the changes happening at your GP practice from 4 July 2023.

We will be transferring your GP registration across to Brierley Park Medical Centre, who will be taking over the running of the services at the Skegby Family Medical Centre. The Partners have decided to merge the NHS contracts for the two practices.

From the 4 July 2023 the practices will be known as Brierley Park Medical Group, Skegby site and Huthwaite site.

Both practices will continue to run as normal and you will have the choice of where you wish to be seen, either at the Skegby site (Mansfield Road, Skegby, Nottingham, NG17 3EE) or the Huthwaite site (127 Sutton Road, Huthwaite, Sutton-in-Ashfield, Nottingham, NG17 2NF).

## You do not need to do anything

You will be automatically transferred across to the Brierley Park Medical Group, which will be completed by 4 July 2023. For more information about Brierley Park Medical Group please visit: https://www.bpmcgp.co.uk/

The location and contact numbers for both practices are staying the same. Whilst the change is taking place, you should continue to contact the practice you are currently registered at, as normal, if you have any symptoms you are worried about, or if you need medical help.

## Registering at a GP practice of your choice

If you would like to register at a different GP practice, you can do this so long as it covers the area where you live.

All GP practices are listed on the NHS website - www.nhs.uk. To register, please put in your postcode for a list of your nearest practices and contact your chosen practice to ask to register with them. Please wait until after 4 July 2023 before registering with a different GP practice, to allow for the transition process to be completed.
