RE: Freedom of Information Request

With reference to your request for information I can confirm in accordance with Section 1 (1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 that we do hold the information that you have requested. A response to your request is below.

In the request you asked:

Please could you kindly provide the following information:

(a) Average waiting time (i.e., number of days) for a child or young person from referral to first appointment with CAMHS/CYPMHS in 2022, or the latest full year for which you have data.

The data below shows average waiting time from referral to assessment and referral to treatment as of 31 March 2022 (most recent full year data). It should be noted that first appointment would normally be the assessment appointment which could include a level of intervention/treatment. Therefore, we have included both referral to assessment and referral to treatment.

Referral to assessment 72 days
