RE: Freedom of Information Request

With reference to your request for information I can confirm in accordance with Section 1 (1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 that we partially hold the information that you have requested. A response to each part of your request is below.

In responding to your request, it is important to note the Integrated Care Board (ICB) is a commissioning organisation and, as such, does not directly provide health services. The ICB's workforce has limited exposure to members of the public as part of their day-to-day working; we do not have any lone worker devices or solutions given the ICB is a low risk health and safety organisation.
