## **RE: Freedom of Information Request**

With reference to your request for information I can confirm in accordance with Section 1 (1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 that we partially hold the information that you have requested. A response to each part of your request is below.

As at end of end of February 23, March 23 data not yet received: The average time for an adult to see a psychiatrist was 39.1 weeks

As at end of end of February 23, March 23 data not yet received: 123 weeks is the longest time for an adult to see a psychiatrist.

As at end of March 22 = 19.6 weeks
