**RE: Freedom of Information Request** 

With reference to your request for information I can confirm in accordance with Section 1 (1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 that we partially hold the information that you have requested. A response to your request is below.

In the request you asked:

- 1. Details of T3 Pathways:
  - a. Please provide a comprehensive outline of the T3 obesity care pathways within your ICB

Patients from Nottingham and Nottinghamshire are referred to the Tier 3 Service at University Hospitals of Derby and Burton NHS Foundation Trust, except for Bassetlaw where they are referred to the services at Doncaster and Bassetlaw Teaching Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust.

Patients must meet the following criteria:

- BMI 40 or above.
- BMI 35 39 with comorbidities (see referral form for details of comorbidities) and has ideally completed a Tier 2 weight management intervention.

All patients who are referred must be willing and able to undertake lifestyle change to lose weight.

Referrals are accepted from GPs, advanced nurse practitioners and specialist physicians.

- 2. Providers of T3 Pathways:
- a. Include the names of providers involved in delivering T3 services within your ICB during this specified timeframe.

Our Tier 3/4 pathway is provided by University Hospitals of Derby and Burton NHS Foundation Trust and Doncaster and Bassetlaw Teaching Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust.

b. Please can you specify if appointments take place face to face, virtually, both or unknown.

Appointments are a mixture of face to face and virtual.

- 3. Volume of Referrals:
- a. Please disclose the total number of referrals made to T3 obesity care services within your ICB between April 1, 2022, and March 31, 2023.

- 4. Patients Commencing T3 Treatment:
- a. Provide the number of patients who commenced T3 obesity treatment within your ICB during the same period of time (April 1, 2022, to March 31, 2023).

Nottingham and Nottinghamshire ICB do not hold this information for questions 3 and 4, please contact University Hospitals Derby and Burton NHS Foundation Trust and Doncaster and Bassetlaw Teaching Hospital NHS Foundation Trust for information.
