RE: Freedom of Information Request

With reference to your request for information I can confirm in accordance with Section 1 (1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 that we do hold the information that you have requested. A response to your request is below.

In the request you asked:

We seek data related to sepsis admissions in specific hospitals across the UK. In particular, we are interested in gathering statistics about hospitals that admit the highest number of sepsis patients within the NHS areas, like Nottingham and Nottinghamshire ICB. This data is critical for our startup's strategic planning, as we intend to collaborate with these hospitals and work closely with healthcare providers in the aforementioned regions. By understanding the distribution of sepsis cases across hospitals, we can make more informed decisions on where to allocate our resources and focus our efforts to make the most significant impact. We'd like to ask for any information or statistics you may have like sepsis admissions, bed counts, etc. in these high-incidence hospitals or contacts to get into direct contact with the aforementioned facilities.

- Data is included for the date range January 2019 to August 2023.
- Data includes activity at all providers for patients registered with a Nottingham and Nottinghamshire ICB GP practice.

If you remain dissatisfied with the outcome of the internal review, you can apply to the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO), who will consider whether the organisation has complied with its obligations under the Act and can require the organisation to remedy any problems. Generally, the ICO cannot make a decision unless you have exhausted the complaints procedure provided by NHS Nottingham and Nottinghamshire ICB.
