**Re: Freedom of Information Request** 

Thank you for your request for information, received on 28 August 2025, regarding lung cancer screening. We have processed your request in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

Under the FOIA, public authorities like ours are required to respond to requests for information within 20 working days. In response to your request, I can confirm that we do hold the information requested.

## Please find below our response to your request:

- 1. Do you have a Lung Cancer Screening [LCS] (or formerly Targeted Lung Health Check [TLHC]) programme running in your ICB region? Yes.

Nottingham and Nottinghamshire ICB.

October 2024 – September 2028.

The plan involves using an external provider to implement a hybrid model of mobile and inhouse scanning, potentially leveraging community diagnostic centre capacity.

This has not yet been agreed.
