Re: Freedom of Information Request

Thank you for your request for information, received on 22 September 2025, and your clarification received on 15 October 2025, regarding rehabilitation services. We have processed your request in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

Under the FOIA, public authorities like ours are required to respond to requests for information within 20 working days. In response to your request, I can confirm that we partially hold the information requested.

Please find below our response to your request:

1. Please list all organisations commissioned to provide rehabilitation services in your area and their contract values.

Community Neuro-rehabilitation Service (provided by Nottinghamshire Healthcare NHS Foundation Trust) provides an integrated, specialist community neuro-rehabilitation service.

Neurology rehabilitation (provided by City Care Partnerships) forms part of the Long Term Conditions Service.

6. Does your organisation have a neuro clinical lead?

No, the ICB does not have a clinical lead for neurology.

7. How do you ensure the needs of people with neurological conditions are addressed in your mental health provision from primary care to acute?

Patients in primary care have access to NHS Talking Therapies for conditions such as anxiety and depression, including when there is also a co-existing long term condition, which can be accessed via self-referral.

8. What specific training and support do you give staff providing mental health and Talking Therapies support to ensure they are equipped to work with people with neurological conditions? If you do not provide this support does another organisation?
