

Document 2 Community Ophthalmology Services Activity Summary


The pilot Community Ophthalmology Services were reviewed during 2012/13, the following information is a summary of the data and outcomes.

a) Community Ophthalmology Triage & Assessment

Data from the Nottingham City Clinical Assessment Service indicates that a total of 4576 Ophthalmology referrals were triaged during 2012/13. The data shows the following outcomes:

Triage Outcome	Number of referrals	% of total referrals triaged
Secondary Care Ophthalmology	2529	56%
Community Optometry Assessment	1547	34%
Community COAG & OHT service	357	8%
Community Low Vision Service	46	1%
Returned to referrer	20	1%

Analysis of the current Community Assessment Service (excluding COAG & OHT) indicates the following outcomes following first appointments:

Discharged 53%

Follow-up 17% (5.5% go on to have a 3rd follow-up)

Onward referral 30%

b) Community COAG & OHT service

Activity data from the Community COAG & OHT service during 13/14 indicates the following:

First Appointments	226
Follow up Appointments	827

c) Community Low Vision Aid Service

Activity data from 2013/14 indicates that a total 67 patients accessed the Low Vision Service and the majority of patients were issued with a low vision aid device.
