**Re: Freedom of Information Request**

Thank you for your request for information, received on 19 November 2025, regarding the use of GLP-1 and other diabetes and weight loss medications across the prison population. We have processed your request in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

Under the FOIA, public authorities like ours are required to respond to requests for information within 20 working days. In response to your request, I can confirm that we do not hold the information requested.

**Details of your request:**

To confirm, I have already contacted NHS England and NHS BSA, who said that NHS ICBs are most likely to hold this information.

I am seeking anonymised, aggregate information covering the period January 2020 to October 2025.

1. Via your ICB, the total number of prescriptions dispensed across the prison population for the following medications, broken down by year: *Victoza (Liraglutide)*, *Ozempic (Semaglutide)*, *Rybelsus (Semaglutide)*, *Trulicity (Dulaglutide)*, *Bydureon (Exenatide)*, and *Mounjaro (Tirzepatide)*
2. Via your ICB, the total number of prescriptions dispensed across the prison population for the following medications, broken down by year: *Saxenda (Liraglutide)*, *Wegovy (Semaglutide)*, *Orlistat (Xenical / Alli)* and *Mysimba (Naltrexone / Bupropion)*
