**Re: Freedom of Information Request**

- Doncaster and Bassetlaw Teaching Hospitals: 121
- Nottingham University Hospitals: 796 (data is January to September 2025).

The ICB does not hold the data for October to December 2025 as the provider is no longer reporting this due to coding issues affecting data quality.

- Sherwood Forest Hospitals: 537.
